QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION

Tears flow through the readings for All Saints' Day. An Old Testament prophet envisions the day when "the Lord God will wipe away the tears from all faces" (Isa. 25:8); a New Testament visionary promises the faithful that God "will wipe every tear from their eyes" (Rev. 21:4); even Jesus weeps at the tomb of his friend Lazarus (John 11:35). What do saints have to do with tears?

Does faithfulness demand suffering? Does it require a certain sort of compassion for the pain of the world?
